Vigilance nabs Junior Engineer for taking bribe of Rs.5,000

Chandigarh, July 23: Economic Offence Wing of Vigilance Bureau Punjab, today nabbed a Junior Engineer Davinder Singh posted at Water Supply Department, Ludhiana red handed while accepting bribe of Rs 5,000.

Disclosing this here today, an official spokesperson of the Vigilance Bureau said that accused Junior Engineer was nabbed red handed on the complaint of Sahib Singh of Gobind Colony(Jamalpur), Ludhiana district. The complainant has approached the VB and alleged that the accused JE was demanding Rs 12,000 for helping him to regularise sewerage connections at his house. The complainant had further informed that he has already paid Rs. 7,000 to the JE as first installment.

After verifying his information, the vigilance team laid a trap and the accused JE was arrested on the spot taking bribe of Rs. 5,000 from the complainant in the presence of two official witnesses.

He informed that a case under different sections of prevention of corruption act has been registered against him at VB police station, Ludhiana and further investigation is under progress.
