Vigilance nabs Private Person for taking bribe of Rs 5,000

Chandigarh, June 30: State Vigilance Bureau today nabbed a Private person Matwal Singh red handed while accepting bribe of Rs 5,000.

Disclosing this here today, an official spokesperson of the Vigilance Bureau said the accused Private person was nabbed red handed on the complaint of Veena, resident of Navi Dana Mandi, district Moga. The complainant has approached the VB and alleged that the accused person was demanding Rs 20,000 for help him in a police case. The complainant had paid Rs. 15,000 to that private person in the first installment.

After verifying his information, the vigilance team laid a trap and the accused person was arrested on the spot taking bribe of Rs. 5,000 from the complainant as a second installment in the presence of two official witnesses.

He informed that a case under section of prevention of corruption act has been registered against him at VB Police Station, Ferozepur and further investigation is under progress.
